

System 44 Grading Form

► Follow these steps when grading *System 44* students.

- 1. Estimate** a student’s performance on each criterion as a percentage. Record the percentages in the Grade column. Example: 90%.
- 2. Prioritize** by assigning each criterion a weight. Ask, “Which of these criteria do I consider the most important?” For accurate class assessment, apply the same weight to each criterion for every student. Record this percentage in the Weight column.
- 3. Multiply** each grade by the weight of importance. Convert percentages to decimals when multiplying, e.g., 95% = .95. Record this number in the Subtotal column. Then add subtotals together and multiply by 100. Record the Final Grade. Convert to letter grades if required.
